Gyalsung training


A De-suung training programme will be conducted to pilot some of the courses included in Gyalsung training. The training period will last three and a half months.

RAWADRANG - MENCHU IRRIGATION WATER PROJECT



The Rawadrang-Menchu irrigation water project under Tongmijangsa Gewog is the third RGoB-De-suung National Service Partnership project completed in Trashiyangtse Dzongkhang. The project was handed over to the community on January 14, 2023.

The project was completed on a set duration, engaging 70 De-suups with support from the RBA, Dzongkhag Administration, and Ministry of Agriculture and Livestock. It will benefit 90 households covering 180 acres of irrigation land in Marshing and Pang Chiwog. The construction was completed at a cost of 23.3 million, with an initial estimate of 31.99 million. The project will boost agriculture production and enhance their income.

The commissioning ceremony was graced by the Hon'ble Dasho Dzongdag of Trashi Yangtse Dzongkhag, and attended by officials from the Dzongkhag Administration, NC, De-suung Office, RBA, RBP, MoAL, MoWHS, Gewog Administration, and the local community.

The survey started on January 20, 2023, and ended on January 30, 2023, covering all eight gewogs in Lhuentshe. A total of 97 De-suups were deployed for the survey.

MFTP TRAINING



On January 23, 2023, 8 De-suups left for Thimphu from Upper Chukha for the Million Fruits Tree Plantation training. They reached the center safely.

Similarly, 15 De-suups from Wangduephodrang, 11 from Punakha, and 3 from Gasa reported to the research center in Bajo for the second phase of MFTP training. The training started on January 24 and will end on January 27.
