

MFTP UPDATE







On 15 August, 1317 De-suups have completed planting a total of 750731 subtropical fruit tree saplings within 3 month in 17 Dzonkghags. Remaining 3 Dzongkhags namely Paro, Thimphu and Gasa has not planted any subtropical sampling due to its high climatic condition. On 1st june the MFTP for subtropical plants began and ended on 15 August. The closing ceremony for MFTP plantation was held in Sarpang presided by MFTP focal of De-suung office, Agriculture team and De-suups of Serpang Dzongkhags.

MASS DOG VACCINATION IN DAGANA





Mass Dog Vaccination (anti rabies) in Dagana were completed on 27th August. 5 male and 5 female De-suups were deployed with livestock officials for this program.

In 2022 and 2023, the Nationwide Accelerated Dog Population Management and Rabies Control Programme sterilised more than 61,000 dogs in the country. Over 58,000 of the total were vaccinated against rabies achieving 94 % vaccination coverage. The centre says that with the continued implementation of different measures, they are hopeful to eliminate dog-mediated human rabies in Bhutan before 2030.

"If you really look into this, it is not only Bhutan that is implementing measures like mass dog vaccination, conducting awareness campaigns, so that people are aware of what they have to do, if they are exposed to suspected animals, as well as educating the community and engaging stakeholders towards achieving this goal.

Although it's very unfortunate we had a recent human case of rabies, it's a big offset to the progress we have been making so far but through these efforts in all the countries in the region as well as in the globe that is taking place, we are confident that we can achieve elimination of dog mediated human rabies by 2030," said Sangay Rinchen.




I don't have personal feelings or opinions. However, I can provide you with some perspectives on how individuals may feel about being a de-suup volunteer for my country.

The next survey would move to Haa, Gasa, Punakha and Wangdue starting from 25th August which will last for another two weeks. After completing the western regions the Ministry plans to cover up the east, central and south regions this winter with the same team of enumerators and few local De-suups familiar with the places. The Ministry plans to enumerate the whole country by this winter.
